It is required that all competitors have drop sheets under competition vehicles in the service parks when performing tasks on their vehicle that require the addition of any/and all fluids or the removal of any/all fluids.

To clarify an error on Page 15 of the 2015 Willunga Hillclimb Supplementary Regulations; the date stated 30th November, 2015 should read 29th November 2015.

It is required that competitors place event supplied decals as per the diagram "Vehicle Decal Layout Advice" with the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

If you receive a re-run, your time on the results will show a time of 3 minutes so the timing team can get results up for other competitors at the end of each run. When your re-run is completed the time of 3 minutes will be replaced with the time you achieved on that re-run.

Change of Service Park for registered vehicles. The Service Park for the registered vehicles will no longer be at "Our Place" at the top of Old Willunga Hill due to the dry year and the danger of fires with hot vehicles. The Service Park for registered vehicles will now be located at the Willunga Recreational Park Oval which is off Main Rd Willunga. Coming from McLaren Vale it is on the right hand side of the road just before the intersection of Main Rd and Aldinga Rd (start of the Main Street of Willunga).

Sunday Scrutineering and Documentation will now be at the Willunga Recreational Park Oval.
